

ORGANIC BASES

1. Ammonia is a weak base.

- a) Use the diagram to explain in words why ammonia is basic.
- b) What is a weak base?
- 2. Methylamine is an example of a primary amine, in which one of the hydrogens in ammonia is replaced by a hydrocarbon group.

Why is methylamine, CH₃NH₂, a stronger base than ammonia?

3. Phenylamine is an example of an aromatic primary amine where the -NH₂ group is attached directly to a benzene ring: $C_6H_5NH_2$.

Why is phenylamine a much weaker base than ammonia?
